Brief Summary of the Workshop

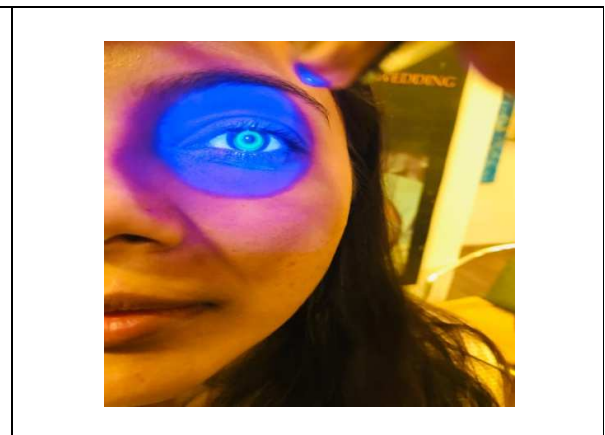

After attending of Vision By Design 2019 an invitation was forwarded to delegates who attended the CME, the invitation was from **Dr.Chandrashekar Chawan (2nd Inventor of RGP Cosmetic Scleral Lenses & Orthokeratologist)**.

Workshop was kept on Myopia Control and Orthokeratology, special hands on training & certification program at Shekhar Eye Research Center, Mulund (E) Mumbai at 14/09/2019, in which 4 Ophthalmologist and 6 Optometrist participated. At the end of workshop we were asked to appear for an online exam which was from **Euclid Emerald (Made in USA & FDA approved)** in which I cleared the exam and got certified as an Orthokeratologist.

Euclid Emerald myopia management is specifically design for child's eye.

Orthokeratology refers to reshaping the cornea using special type of contact lens to reduce refractive errors such as myopia, hyperopia and astigmatism. This contact lens is supposed to be used while sleeping at night time. This method can be used as an alternative to eyeglasses, refractive surgery, or for those who prefer not wear contact lenses during the day.
