



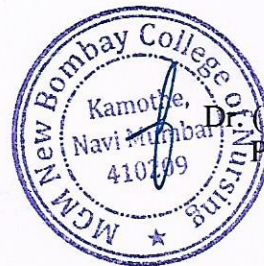

We have prepared SOP for identification of slow and advanced learners, modification of teaching methods and outcome monitoring. We have offered special programs for slow and advanced learners.





Following measures were undertaken for improving their performance respectively.

**Mentorship programme** is conducted to understand the difficulties faced by students and enhance their coping mechanism. This programme also helps the faculty understand the student's learning styles and in turn helps them to improve their academic performance.

**Remedial Lectures** are conducted for students facing difficulty in academics, the session are tailor made based on feedback received from students in mentorship programme. In these sessions students are given feedback on methods of preparing for examination and pattern of writing answers. These sessions provide a platform for understanding difficult concepts with more attention.


Biannually **Parent Teacher's Meeting** is conducted to discuss the student academic performance with the parents enabling them to take up an active role in learning process.
