#### Report on Learning Management System - DaxTa system

Date: 22/03/2021

Venue: MGM School of Physiotherapy, Navi Mumbai.

Attended by: 55 Students of IV BPT regular batch 2020-21 and 8 faculty members

#### The following points were observed in teacher interface of DaxTa system:

- 1. 60 students registered on the portal, but only 25-30 students are able to access the portal. Error of student not in the classroom still persists in spite of multiple attempts of regenerating password as advised by software developers.
- 2. Audio heard in live lecture is not clear.
- 3. Timer for quiz was set to 10 seconds but the question appeared on the screen of students for less than 5 seconds as reported by students.
- 4. Option to 'ask live' question only appears on full screen mode and not minimized mode.

### The following points were observed in student interface of DaxTa system:

- 1. Live lecture recording option is now available on the interface. It can be started and stopped at multiple intervals thereby creating new recording file.
- 2. While recording is ongoing, screen sharing option is unavailable as well as option to turn off the camera.
- 3. Quiz mode allows the teacher to set the timer for question and options to stay visible to students although on student portal it appeared for much less duration.
- 4. Quiz questions do not get stored in any bank, it was not visible post lecture or even during lecture.








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5. Post quiz immediate feedback of answers and response was shown to the teach as a pop-up.



- 6. Teachers were unable to upload assignments as the classroom to be selected in dialogue box gave no option whereas the classroom created is SOP Final year.
- 7. Only JPEG, PNG, PDF and DOC files can be uploaded as assignments and not PPTx





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8. After lecture is completed a summary of recording, assignment and quiz appears as a pop-up on the screen.

#### Report on Learning Management System - QuikLrn system

Date: 09/06/2021

Venue: MGM School of Physiotherapy, Navi Mumbai.

Attended by: 59 Students of IV BPT regular batch 2020-21 and 10 faculty members

As instructed by the University, MGM School of Physiotherapy, Navi Mumbai completed the trial for QuikLrn learning management system. Ms. Nupoor Jain conducted an orientation and introductory session for all faculty members on 07<sup>th</sup> May 2021. WhatsApp group was also created for easier resolution of errors and troubles faced by any faculty member. Dr. Hiranmayee Bagwe (PT) coordinated the learning activity in the platform with QuikLrn staff and faculty members of MGM School of Physiotherapy, Navi Mumbai.

#### The following points were observed in teacher interface of QuikLrn system:

- 1. The interface is user friendly and easy to comprehend. For some faculty members terminologies seemed like technical jargon for example 'cloud repository'
- 2. Clear and differentiated segregations were present on the dashboard.
- 3. Attendance marking was manual and would be great if it is automated process.
- 4. Live sessions can be recorded. Flexibility to opt out of recording also available.
- 5. Availbility of white board and annotations for stduents as well as teachers make it more interative
- 6. A variety of assessment stools present like quizzes, polls, forums, disucssions present
- 7. Learning material can be uploaded with ease
- 8. It has a lot of flexibility to format and rename each and every header and description to create chapters according to topics.
- 9. Screen sharing is good. Occasional lag present while switching to screen share mode. Audio lags occassionaly.
- 10. QuikLrn platform encourages teachers to explore newer and innovative methods of teaching learning.
- 11. Lecture scheduling and timetable is clearly visible and sends alerts on time.



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### The following points were observed in student interface of QuikLrn system:

- 1. Students found the interface creative and interesting
- 2. Students reported they were waiting for content tabs as were shown to them during orientation
- 3. The feature to add notes to contents and go to revision mode would be extremely helpful and encouraging.
- 4. Drawback faced by students was there was no mobile application available. They required desktop browser to log into the session
- 5. Students with low to medium internet speed faced difficult with audio as well as visibility of screen shared content
- 6. Mute and unmute is easier on video calling applications compared to QuikLrn interface.

QuikLrn support team coordinated by Ms. Nupoor Jain were very active and patient with all our issues and doubts. Multiple sessions were taken in order to orient the faculty with the process. Students were instructed to mail their issues on their support email ID which was resolved immediately.

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# Report of workshop on "Basic course in Teachers Training programme for Allied Health Science Professionals" (MGM Physiotherapy, Nursing, SBS & Dept of Prosthetics and Orthotics)

held from: 17<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> August 2021 (First Batch) & 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> August 2021 (Second Batch)

The Medical Education Unit of MGM Medical College, Navi-Mumbai conducted the "Basic course in Teachers Training programme for Allied Health Science Professionals (MGM Physiotherapy, Nursing, SBS & Dept of Prosthetics and Orthotics)" in two batches from: 17th – 18th August 2021 (First Batch) & 25th – 26th August 2021 (Second Batch).

The MEU Members who had successfully completed the MET workshop at the Nodal Centre were included as resource faculty for the workshop. The Program titled "Basic course in Teachers Training programme for Allied Health Science Professionals" was conducted from 17th – 18th August 2021 (First Batch) & 25th – 26th August 2021 (Second Batch).

### Day one of the workshop:

The first day of the workshop started with Registration and breakfast. The participants were divided into 4 groups. Respected Dean Dr. G.S. Narshetty inaugurated the workshop, welcomed



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and addressed the audience. The MEU Co-ordinator, Dr. Mrunal Pimparkar gave the workshop orientation to the participants. The participants filled the pre test forms.





Report of workshop on "Curriculum Implementation Support Programme (CISP) II" conducted

by MGM Medical College, Navi-Mumbai from 23<sup>rd</sup> -24<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

The Medical Education Unit of MGM Medical College, Navi-Mumbai conducted the MCI recognized workshop on "Curriculum Implementation Support Programme (CISP) II" under the governance of the Nodal/ Regional centre -Seth. G.S. Medical College & KEM Hospital, from 23rd -24<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

**Dr. Munira Hirkani,** Associate Professor, Physiology, Seth G.S. Medical College & KEM Hospital, Parel, Mumbai was appointed as the MCI observer for this workshop.

MGM Medical College, Navi-Mumbai is grateful to Medical Council of India for granting permission to conduct these workshops under the aegis of Nodal Centre, GSMC-KEM Hospital, Mumbai. Continuous guidance and inputs regarding the conduct of the workshop and knowledge resources were provided by GSMC KEMH, Mumbai, for the workshop. We are

extremely indebted to the entire MEU faculty from GSMC KEMH for helping us to conduct the workshop effectively.

The Curriculum Committee Members and MEU members who had successfully completed the CISP workshop at the Nodal Centre were included as resource faculty for the workshop. A MEU meeting was called and the faculties were explained the outlines and objectives of the workshop. The List of topics and related resource material were distributed to the faculty members. The various speakers discussed their topics and finalized the content, duration, handouts, role play and group activities for the participants. The certificates were printed as per the format given by the Nodal centre.

Faculties from preclinical, para clinical and clinical departments of the college were selected. Prior to the workshop, a day before, the MEU had called a meeting for all participants, wherein they were briefed about the coming 2 days workshop, schedule and necessary instructions were given to them.

The IT Department was called to make necessary setting and installation of cameras, AV Aids for the MCI Observer to observe the whole workshop ONLINE. A day before the workshop an ONLINE mock drill was taken by Dr. Munira, MCI Observer to look into the arrangements made. Dr. Munira approved the IT settings and other arrangements.

The total no. of participants who attended the CISP II workshop from 23<sup>rd</sup> -24<sup>th</sup> November 2020 were 29. One participant Dr. Madhur Rai, Assistant Professor, Physiology, from the list sent earlier, could not attend this workshop due to medical reasons. Instead with permission from MCI Observer, Dr. Santanu Mallik, Assistant Professor, Anatomy, attended the workshop in place of Dr. Madhur Rai. Dr. Ajay Shendarkar, Professor, FMT whose name was sent in earlier list, was absent for the workshop due to medical reasons. All the participants were from the parent college. Their designations were as follows: a) Professor- 11, b) Associate Professor- 5, c) Assistant Professor- 11 and Tutor-2. Faculties from preclinical, para clinical, medicine and

allied and surgery and allied disciplines were 6, 10, 7 & 6 respectively. The list of participants is attached in the Annexure I.

The Program titled "Curriculum Implementation Support Programme (CISP) II" was conducted for a period of 2 days from 23<sup>rd</sup> -24<sup>th</sup> November 2020, and the copy of programme is attached in Annexure II.

#### Day one (23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020) of the workshop:

The first day (23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020) of the workshop started with Registration and breakfast. The participants were divided into 5 groups. The MEU Co-ordinator, Dr. Mrunal Pimparkar welcomed MCI observer Dr. Munira Hirkani and addressed the audience and gave the workshop orientation to the participants. Pretest was administered to the participants.

Dr.Mrunal Pimparkar began with "Ice breaking and introduction of participants and faculty". This was followed by sessions on "Competency based medical education (CBME)", which was taken by Dr. Anjali Sabnis & Dr. Rita Khadkikar and "IMG: Goals, roles &Competencies" was taken by Dr. Bageshree Seth. There was lot of enthusiasm among the participants during the activity. Dr. A. D. Urhekar & Dr. Ipseeta Ray took a session on "Deriving objectives from competencies", while Dr. Jaishree Ghanekar & Dr. Mrunal Pimparkar took session on "Linking competency objectives to Teaching Learning Methods (TLM)". Group activity was given and was well appreciated by all participants.

Following lunch, Dr. Shilpi Sahu took the session on "Graduate Medical Education Regulations". The session was very much appreciated by all participants. This was followed by sessions on "Electives" conducted by Dr. Darpan Kaur, followed by "Foundation Course and Early Clinical Exposure" by Dr. Mrunal Pimparkar & Dr. Kalpana R and "AETCOM module" by Dr. Ipseeta Ray & Dr. Rita Khadkikar.

The speakers shared their most cherishing teaching learning experience with the audience. The day ended with feedback on the sessions conducted during that day. The participants filled the required feedback / evaluation forms.

## Day two (24th November 2020) of the workshop:

On day two- Dr. Kalpana Rajeev Kumar conducted session on "Student Doctor -Clinical Teaching", while Dr. Ipseeta Ray & Dr. A. D. Urhekar spoke on "Alignment and Integration". Thereafter there was a session on "Skills training" by Dr. Bageshree Seth & Dr. Darpan Kaur.

The sessions were brainstorming and after lot of deliberations, the participants came up with a constructive feedback. Dr. Jaishree Ghanekar & Dr. Anjali Sabnis took session on "Assessment in CBME".

This was followed by session on "Aligning assessment to competency objectives & TLM" which was jointly taken by Dr. Shilpi Sahu & Dr Rita Khadkikar. Both the sessions generated a lot of curiosity and interest to learn more. Dr. Mrunal Pimparkar conducted session on" Curricular governance". The participants found the sessions quite interactive and informative. The participants were given various exercises, which was effectively done.

The participants then filled the required feedback and evaluation forms and post test. Following open house, the programme ended with a Valedictory Function. Many participants and speakers spoke about their experiences and gave constructive feedback. The participants appreciated the workshop and assured that they would implement what they learned from the various sessions.

Newer topics in CBME curriculum, such as Foundation Course at the beginning of MBBS course, Electives and Early clinical exposure was dealt with in details by the faculty and generated tremendous response from the participants regarding its planning and implementation. The concept of integration and alignment of the subjects along with designing the time-table was

also addressed. However, concerns were raised regarding the time frame for implementation, need for more faculty and need for support staff for effective implementations and documentation.

The sessions were assessed by the participants using evaluation forms from the MCI. The point's alloted by the participants showed a significant improvement in knowledge and importance after each session. The participants were extremely satisfied with the overall arrangements and conduct of the workshop.

















