### 3. SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS:

Supplementary examination shall be conducted within 6 months or 6 weeks so that the students who pass can join the main batch and the failed students will have to appear in the subsequent year

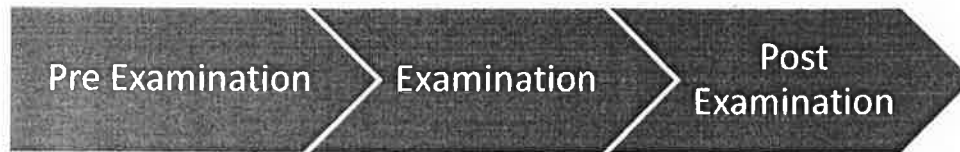
Examinations are conducted for failure to secure minimum pass marks in Theory or Practical examination of a paper or failure to appear in any Theory or Practical examination on any grounds including medical shall be eligible for Supplementary examination in that particular paper.

Those Students, ineligible from appearing in examination due to shortage of attendance in Theory or Practical, Internal assessment may also be eligible for Supplementary examination subject to the condition that they have to attend the classes in that particular paper whenever it is offered by the institute.

All UG & PG supplementary examinations conducted as per regulatory bodies.

# CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION

## THREE PHASES OF EXAMINATION PROCESS ADOPTED



### A| PRE-EXAMINATION :

#### **1. EXAMINATION NOTIFICATION :**

Display of University notification for theory and practical time table on website with copy to all concerned by e-mail/ fax / post for display in notice boards, 3 months prior to examination along with time-table.

#### **2. ONLINE SUBMISSION OF EXAMINATION APPLICATION FORMS AND PAYMENT GATEWAY FOR EXAMINATION FEES**

- a. Students to submit on line forms and pay fees, followed by depositing e- receipt with subject wise details through the institution Head.
- b. E-forms generation with subject to approval of the respective Head of Institutes, verifying eligibility and subjects, as per time-table

#### **3. GENERATION OF SEAT NUMBERS AND HALL TICKETS**

- a. Online generation of seat number and hall tickets.
- b. Option to download hall tickets by students if eligible, after completing all formalities as in para-2 above; 3 days prior to commencement of examination.

#### **4. GENERATION OF BAR-CODES FOR ANSWER SHEETS**

- a. Online barcode generation in sets of as per requirement for answer books A, B, C will be ensured in respect of each candidate.
- b. The same has to be pasted by the invigilator at examination hall while verifying identity of respective candidates subject wise and paper-wise at the specified boxes. The photo and mini-barcode will be pre-printed on attendance sheet.

#### **5. MODERATION OF QUESTIONS PAPERS**

- a. Question papers will be set on-line by examiners, internals and externals chosen from the MGMIHS examiners approved panel or as per rules applicable programme wise.
- b. The University question bank may be used for the purpose of generating the question sets, by the paper-setters.
- c. The difficulty level in question maintained as stipulated by respective statutory bodies. This ratio is intimated to paper setters.

## CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION

- d. All sets of question papers so received are to be moderated by an external examiner from outside MGMIHS online. Minimum 2 sets to be retained in encrypted format for blue printing subsequently by the University for blue printing on the day of examination.

### 6. INSTANT PRINTING OF QUESTION PAPERS AT RESPECTIVE CENTRES AND DIRECT DISTRIBUTION AT EXAMINATION HALLS.

- a. The university server will decide a final set of question papers at random from the moderated question papers. On the day of examination, the same has to be downloaded by the centre In-charge and printed under proper security at examination centres for distribution, to candidates instantly as per scheduled date and time for a particular paper.
- b. For this purpose, a dedicated computer system with webcam and appropriate printing device will be placed at examination centres 30 minutes before a particular paper, the Dean or his nominated faculty (Centre In-charge), whose credentials pre-registered in the University examinations server, will login after generating a pass word, followed by an OTP in his registered mobile or email id.
- c. The down loaded question paper will be Xeroxed immediately, for distribution to students at examination hall, ensuring all security measures.

### 7. APPOINTMENT OF INVIGILATOR VIGILANCE SQUADS :

A Vigilance Squad/s of not less than three and not more than four members is appointed by the Vice-Chancellor to visit each examination centre to:

- a. Ensure that the University Examinations are conducted as per norms laid down.
- b. Observe whether the Senior Supervisors and Block-Supervisors are following scrupulously instructions for conduct of the University examinations.
- c. Check the students who try to resort to malpractices at the time of University Examinations and report such cases to the University.
- d. Visit any Examination Centre without prior intimation and enter office of the Incharge of Examination Centre to check the record and other material relating to the conduct of examination. They can enter in any block of Examination for checking the candidate's identity card, hall tickets etc. to ascertain the authenticity of the candidate. The Vigilance Squad is authorized to detect use of malpractices and unfair means in the University Examination and report directly to the University.

# CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION

## BI EXAMINATION

### 1. CONDUCTION OF THEORY EXAMINATION

Invigilators issue question papers to the candidates at the appointed time. Unused question papers are returned to the University. The Candidates write the examinations on the Answer sheets provided by the Examination Centers.

## CI POST EXAMINATION

### 1. WRITTEN PAPER EVALUATION PROCESS AT CAP CENTRE

- a. Internet or local Wi-Fi is made available for digital evaluation of written papers at the CAP Centre
  - b. One notepad and an android mobile hand set is provided to each examiner for digital evaluation and uploading marks in theory and practical's, using optical character recognition software.
  - c. MCQ are evaluated centrally at the MGMIHS examination centre by OMR.
  - d. In the CAP Centre, the concerned examiner has to scan the codified barcode pasted on the face of answer book by which, a particular evaluation table will open up on his mobile screen for marking process. Simultaneously the answer book has to be placed on the e-notepad for the purpose.
  - e. In case of any ineligible character or wrong calculation, the marks glow red on mobile set. After making necessary corrections, the examiner clicks on "Send" button to finally upload marks in MGMIHS central server directly.
2. Tabulation and analyses :The system captures marks secured in written, viva voce, practical and internal examination by candidate to decide result on passing heads as per MGMIHS examination Rules, read with related Regulations of respective statutory bodies.
  3. The grace marks as per respective council regulation are awarded before finalization of result.
  4. The results to be declared within 3 days for post-Graduate examination and within one week for under-graduate examination.
  5. Grievance Redressal Mechanism (Reevaluation) Any student may apply for verification / photocopying / reevaluation. Following this, the answer sheets are verified (retotaling) / photocopied / reevaluated as the case may be.

Graph -1 :Final MBBS Pass out Student Result

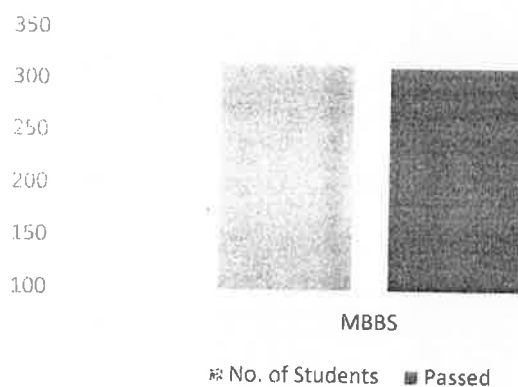

Graph 2 : MD/MS Pass out Student Result

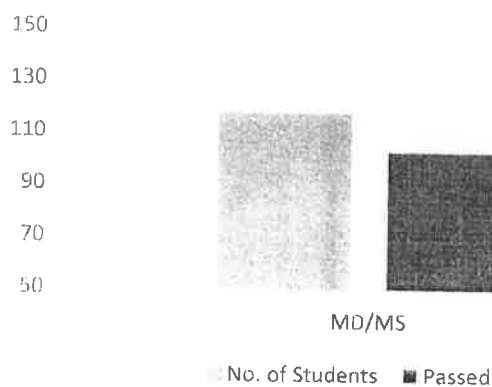
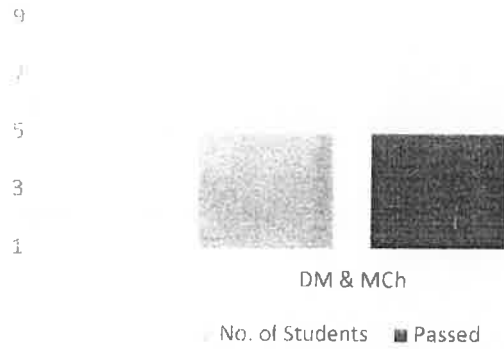

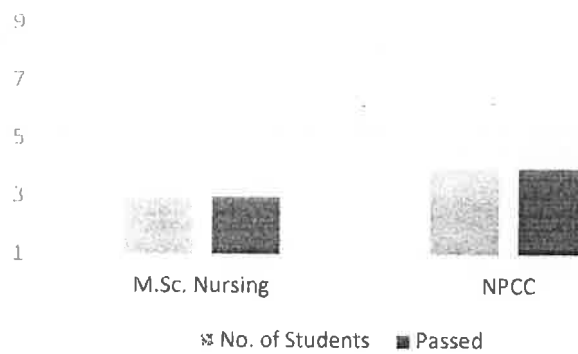

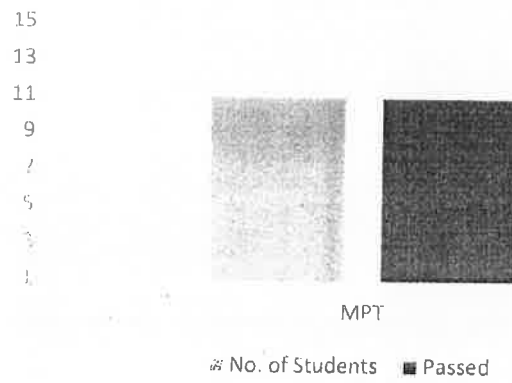

Graph 4: M.Sc.(Allied Health Sciences)Pass out Student Result

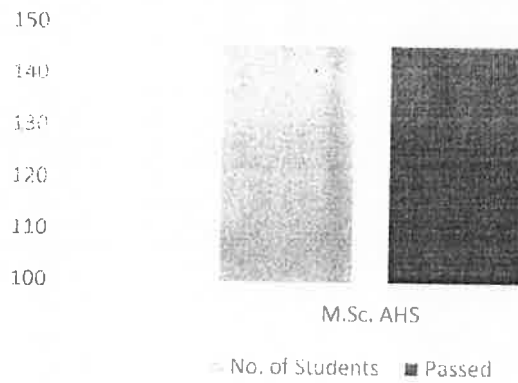
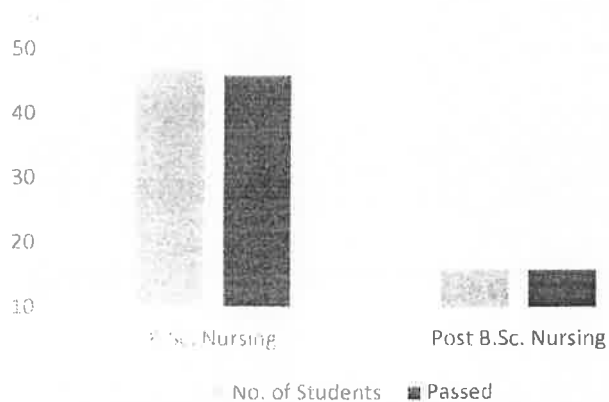

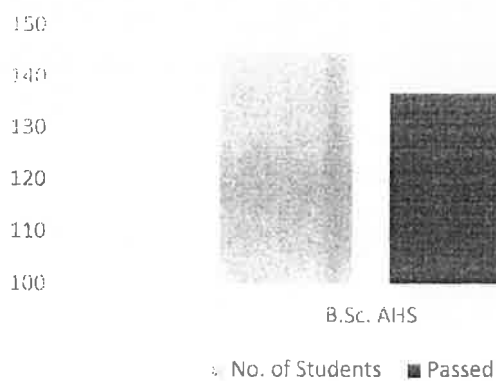
**Graph 5 :Post B BSc. Nursing and B.Sc.Nursing Pass out Student Result**

Graph 5 :BPO, BPT& BPTTh Pass out Student Result

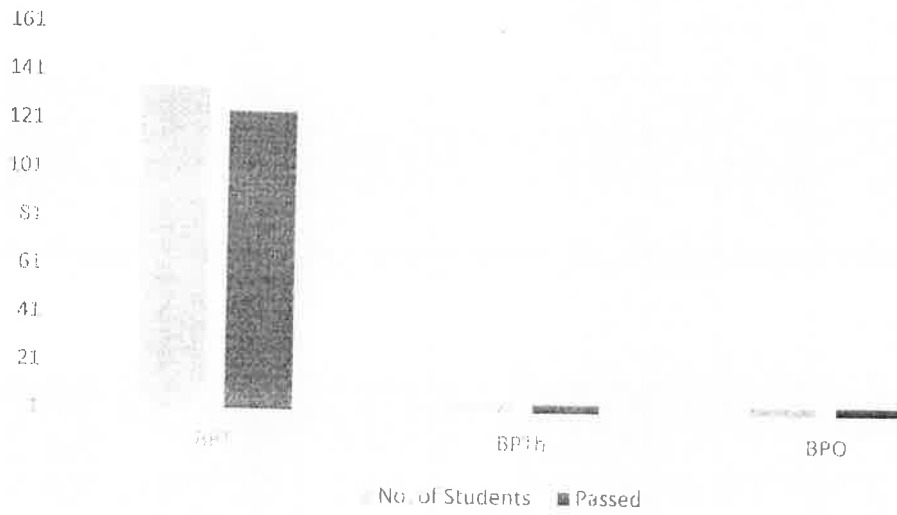

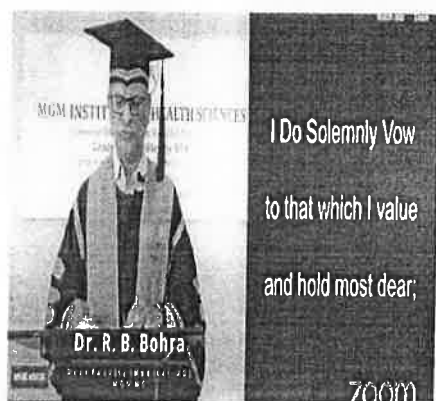
