



### HAZARDS OF GLOBAL WARMING

Global warming is the long-term heating of Earth's climate system observed since the pre-industrial period due to human activities, primarily fossil fuel burning, which increases heat-trapping greenhouse gas levels in Earth's atmosphere.

Global warming is expected to have far-reaching, long-lasting and, in many cases, devastating consequences for planet Earth. A few of its hazards include:

- Increase in average temperatures and temperature extremes.
- Extreme weather events.
- Melting glaciers.
- Rising Sea levels and ocean acidification.
- Extinction of Plant and animal species.
- Frequent wild fires.
- Long periods of draught or floods in certain areas.



#### **BENEFITS OF TREE PLANTATION**

One of the few things that can be done at a personal level to control global warming is planting more trees. Tree plantation offers many benefits, which include:

#### **A. Environmental Benefits**

- Trees reduce the urban heat island effect through evaporative cooling and reducing the amount of sunlight that reaches parking lots and buildings. This is especially true in areas with large impervious surfaces, such as parking lots of stores and industrial complexes.
- They improve our air quality by filtering harmful dust and pollutants such as ozone, carbon monoxide, and sulphur dioxide from the air we breathe and give off oxygen that we need to breathe.
- Trees reduce the amount of storm water runoff, which reduces erosion and pollution in our waterways and may reduce the effects of flooding.
- Many species of wildlife depend on trees for habitat. Trees provide food, protection, and homes for many birds and mammals.

#### **B.** Communal Benefits

- Tress provide a collective benefit to you as well as your neighbours.
- Tree lined streets have a traffic calming effect, traffic moves more slowly and safely.
- Trees can be placed to screen unwanted views or noise from busy highways.
- Trees can complement the architecture or design of buildings or entire neighbourhoods.

#### **C. Economic Benefits**

- Well placed trees can reduce your cooling costs in the summer by shading the south and west sides of your home. If deciduous trees are used, they will allow the sun to pass through and warm your home in the winter.
- Evergreen trees on the north side of your home and shrubs around the foundation of your home can act as a windbreak to reduce the cooling effects of winter winds.

• The value of a well landscaped home with mature healthy trees can be as much as 10% higher than a similar home with no or little landscaping.



A prior meeting with the sarpanch of maldunge village was held and they were informed about the tree plantation drive that was going to take place on  $16^{\text{th}}$  July,2021.

The forest department was made aware of this initiative, and was asked to provide us with the saplings needed for the tree plantation drive.

- To orient the students with the clinical areas and Extension activities conducted at MGM hospital, Navi Mumbai.



UGC has issued letters dated 19.07.2011, 02.07.2013, 07.03.2016, 05.09.2016, 15.05.2017, 04.06.2018, 26.06.2019 and 14.09.2020 with the request to Universities to take the following action:

- The Officials/faculty members should desist from any act of discrimination against SC/ST students on grounds of their social origin.
- The University/Institute/College may develop a page on their website for lodging such complaints of caste discrimination by SC/ST students and also place a complaint register in the Registrar/Principal Office for the purpose. If any such incident comes to the notice of the authorities, action should be taken against the erring official/faculty members promptly.
- The university and colleges should ensure that no official/faculty members indulge in any kind of discrimination against any community or category of students.
- The University may constitute a committee to look into the discrimination complaints received from the SC/ST/OBC Students /Teachers and non-teaching staff.

You are requested to advise the officials/faculty members of your university/Institute to be more sensitive while dealing with incidents of caste discrimination. You are also requested to provide information for the year 2020-21 in the prescribed format on the University Activity Monitoring Portal (UAMP) of 'UGC at link <u>https://ugc.ac.in/uamp/</u>) urgently.







Research work with consent of the patients and even maintenance of privacy of patients is been done.

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
