1] To confirm the Minutes and Action Taken Report of the meeting held on 23.07.2021:

Action taken report on the minutes of the meeting held on 23.07.2021 were discussed point-wise and were unanimously confirmed.

Item No. 2] Approval of Publication Incentives for the year 2021 (January to October):

Publication Incentives proposal for the year 2021 ((January to October) were Discussed.

In course of the discussions, Prof. Sandeep Rai suggested to give incentives to all authors who have their name as authors from any of the Constituent Units of MGMIHS. In view of ongoing interdisciplinary research in Medicine and Allied discipline and depending upon contribution of particular author in the said research paper, the incentive can be shared. Such specific contributions should have evidence in the authorship form at submission or specified in the contents of the paper will be taken into account. In the event of multiple authors, the incentive may be equally distributed among all authors, who are from any of the MGMIHS Constituent Institutes.

Resolution 2: It was resolved that, the above suggestions to equally distribute the incentive amount among all authors of research paper published only in Scopus, Web of Science or PubMed Indexed Journal, irrespective of whether Ist author or corresponding author as specified in MGMIHS Rules earlier to the competent authority for consideration.

Item No. 3] Incentives for Best Scientific Paper Award for the year 2020:

The members went through the evaluation sheet submitted by the evaluators for the Best Paper Award. The existing MGMIHS rules for Best Scientific Paper Award were also read out to clarify the award for the Best Scientific Paper Award. Only papers in Scopus,Web of Science and PubMed were accepted for the award. Papers outside these were not considered:

Resolution No.3:

As per the Resolution No. 4 of BOM 56/2019 dated 27.01.2019 and its amendment BOM58/2019 dated 19.07.2019, the Best Scientific Paper Award for year 2020 was recommended unanimously as below:

3.1 MGMIHS Best Scientific Paper Award - Faculty:

- MGMIHS Best Scientific Paper Award PG/PhD Scholars: 3.2 An Award of Rs. 15,000/- with Certificate to Dr. Priyanka Amonkar, MD Pediatrics, Resident, MGM Medical College & Hospital, Kamothe, Navi Mumbai.
- Under UG Category: Only one paper was submitted, published in a 3.3 journal registered under google scholar, not falling under ambit of MGMIHS Rules(Scopus/Web of Science / PubMed). Hence could not be recommended for award.

The meeting started with the discussion on Selection of Books and Chapters for Incentives for the period from 2019 to 2021:

I. Incentives to Books and Chapters in Books:

The relevant books and Chapters in books published by faculty of MGMIHS under consideration for incentives by MGMIHS were placed before the Committee by the Librarian on request.

The Committee evaluated the books and chapters from 2019 to 2021, for incentives as per the Resolution No.7 of BOM-52/2018 dated 13.01.2018.

The authors of books and chapters in books for incentives are as follows:

Books not accepted for Incentives:

- 1. Ajita Suhrid Annachhatre. Acquaint yourself with anesthesia, Aurangabad: Yashwant Graphic, 2019: Has only 26 pages and no ISBN.

Chapters for Incentive:

Chapters were reviewed by the committee. The Committee unanimously approved all 23 chapters for incentives to be given to the authors as(Annexure A).

II. After the books/chapters were approved for incentives discussion on Item No. 2 of the Policy for Incentives for Publication of Research Paper, Books and Book Chapters approved by BOM/63/201 dated 17.2.2021 was taken up and the following suggestions were put-forth by the members for amendment of the Policy

No.1: It was proposed to include Professor (Emeritus) also to be eligible for the award.

No.2: Faculty should be author or co-author

No.3: Contents of the book should be free from Plagiarism

No.4: The term "book" and "booklet" be used as defined by UNESCO (Book 30000 to 40000 words, booklet 10000 to 20000 words) as authentic.

No.5: The incentive may be equally shared amongst all the authors, depending on subject to the conditions that the author(s) are members/part of MGMIHS.

No.6: Distribution of Incentives:
