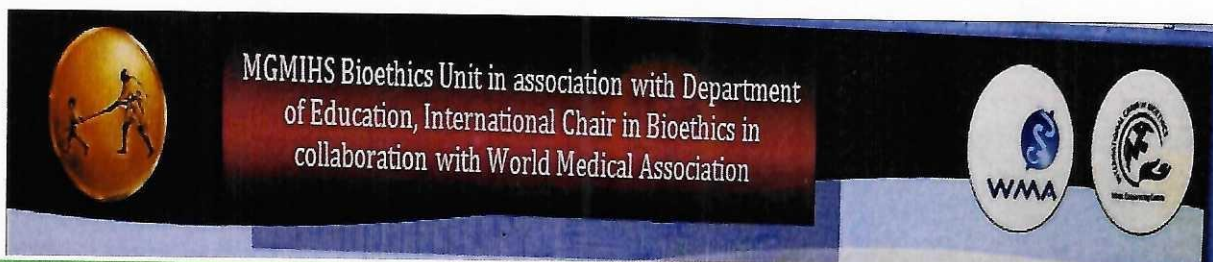

- Responsible behavior of individuals towards their societies in prevention of Monkey pox outbreak

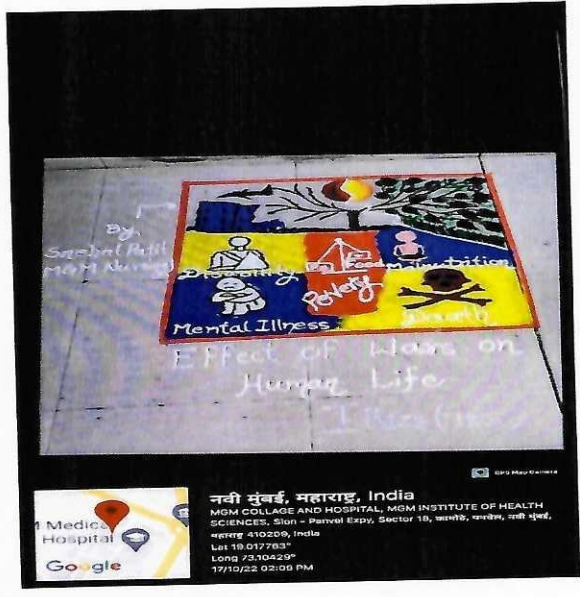

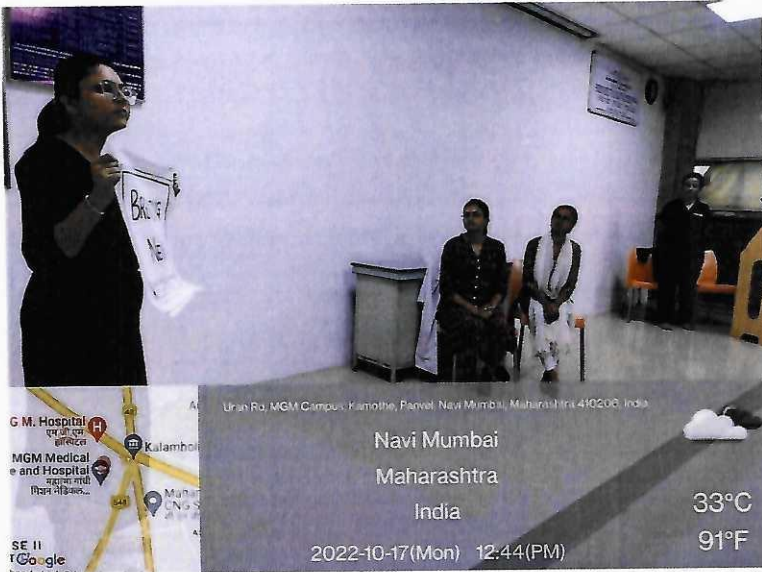

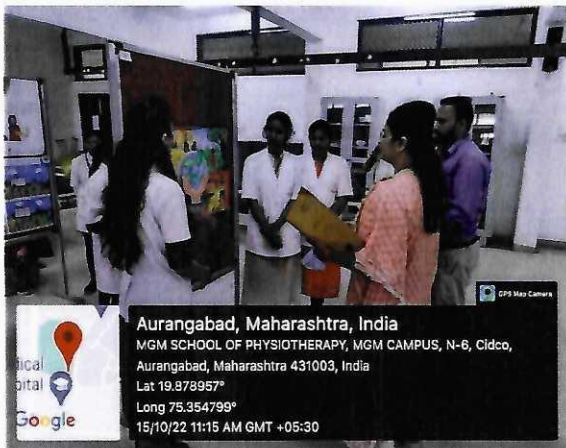
