 - o Create a schedule of events for the exam date (RCPCH can provide template and host team will receive support for this from PPIs)
 - o Welcome email from host team - provide local point of contact, share the schedule of events, request answers to confirm attendance, request examiners, travel itineraries, request examiner phone numbers etc.
 - o Coordinate examiner travel - book taxis for airport pickup, travel to/from exam centre
 - o Book hotel accommodation
 - o Organise examiner dinner
 - o Create WhatsApp group to keep everyone updated during the exam date.

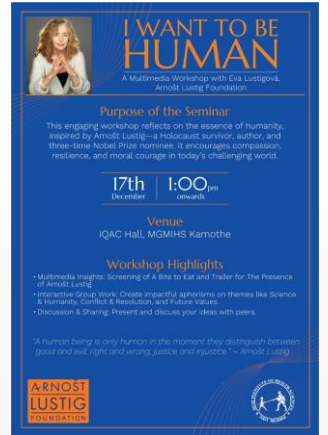
Conduction of 4 multidagnostic camps at Bazaar Sawangi, Warud Kazi, Waluj and Fulambri as a part of Project i2EYE (a community service initiative of Medical Students of National University of Singapore and Rotary International). A total of 1800 patients were screened which included 450 school children, The patients were screened for Hypertension, Diabetes, malnutrition, complete ophthalmic evaluation including retinal screening with a hand-held retinal camera and Pediatric dry eyes evaluation. 800 patients had a blood work up done and 50 women were screened for cervical cancer on site. This camp was a combined effort of all the departments with a massive contribution from the medical students of both **National University of Singapore** and MGM Medical College Aurangabad. 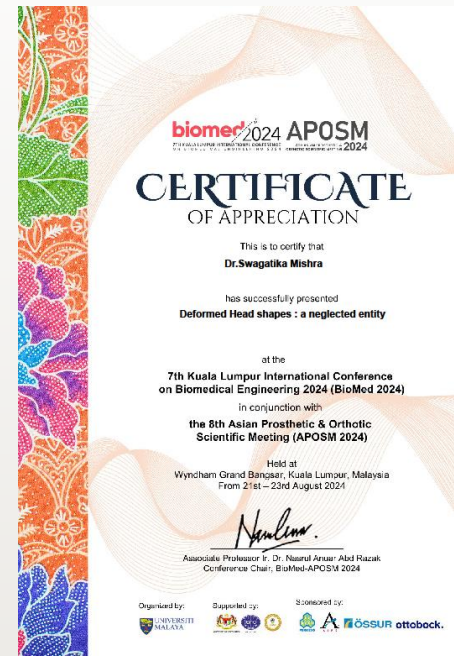
