We have received the letter of permission from National Medical commission. At the beginning, the intake capacity sanctioned is 50. In the state of Maharashtra, out of 14 colleges including government and private, only two have received the LoP. This is a matter of proud to all of us.
- 2. ITEM NO. 1: Hon'ble Vice Chancellor's brief

Dr. Nitin N Kadam, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members. He briefed as follows:-

- 1. As per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, Health Ministry has directed all the institutions to provide all the details of current safety measures taken by the institutions and future measures which will be taken to the Health Ministry.
- 2. MGMIHS has a student ratio of 70 % Females and 30% males And staff and faculty ratio of 60% Females and 40% males.
- 3. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor informed that the HOI should take immediate action for any complaints received without delaying the process and strict punishment to be implemented.
- 4. All corrective measures should be taken for the safety of students, faculty and staff.

ITEM NO. 2: Each Institute Head will present a brief note on "Students and Staff Safety in the premises".

All the Institute Heads (including NON MGMIHS units) discussed all the safety measures taken by their units and improvement / additional measures required.

AFTER DISCUSSIONS ON VARIOUS MATTERS, IT WAS RESOLVED:-

1. Adequate separate duty rooms with attached washrooms for male and female doctors on each floor/unit of the hospital.

- 2. Central Rooms / Changing Rooms for other specialties (Nurses / Biomedical / Physiotherapy) with attached washrooms for males and females separately in each floor of the hospital.
- 3. High resolution cameras to be placed in critical areas. All installed cameras to be functional. Additional cameras to be installed where required. One dedicated IT person to monitor the CCTV 24x7.
- 4. Adequate lighting in the campus and critical / dark / disserted areas to be identified.
- 5. Wards / class rooms which are not operative should be locked.
- 6. Increase in male/female security guards
- 7. Well-rehearsed Code Purple.
- 8. Display of posters in surveillance areas in three languages with Penalty clause.
- 9. Entry of vehicles without name plates to be restricted.
- 10. Regular self defense training to be done periodically for staff and students.
- 11. Contract / Housekeeping staff Police verification and pass mandatory.
- 12. Parking building rounds to be taken by the security daily.
- 13. One patient One relative system to be followed at the hospital.
- 14. Panic buttons to be installed at various places. Penalty (strict punishment) for false alarm to be known to all concern.
- 15. Two additional social workers to be appointed at the hospital at Kamothe.
- 16. Complaint boxes on each floor of the hospital/institutes placed and action taken accordingly.
- 17. Faculties to be proactive and vigilant.
- 18. Mentor/Mentee/Buddy/GPS monitoring system to be installed.
- 19. Awareness program of law and order to be organized.
- 20. Male/Female security in civilian clothes to overlook all the functioning.
- 21. Lady Librarian after office hours required.
- 22. Inhouse Psychologist for periodically counselling the staff/students.
- 23. Problem solving meetings by HOI once in 15 days.
- 24. Coffee with Dean/Principal/Director to be held quarterly with students for general discussion (no academics).
- 25. Coordination with parents of students as and when necessary.
- 26. I Cards a must for everyone in the campus.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and Hon'ble Medical Director directed all the HOI's to email their suggestions and views on "Students and Staff Safety in the premises" to the Registrar. They further informed that the Registrar shall prepare a SOP which should be strictly followed by all HOI's.
