**Preamble:** This meeting of special Board of Examinations has been organized in view of recent rise in remuneration of examiner in accordance with MUHS as per BOM 38/2014 resolution no 4.6. The examination fee has not been revised since 2007. The remuneration for examiners is revised from time to time as per MUHS i.e. four times. As automation is also proposed in whole examination system expenditure is likely to increase. In this view revision exercise is proposed in this meeting for medical (UG/PG, Superspeciality and PhD) programmes. There is also need to streamline examination fees of CBCS programmes (Nursing, Biomedical & Physiotherapy programmes)

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor presided over the meeting and welcomed all the members. He briefed them about the agenda of the meeting, Dr. Parineeta Samant, Controller of Examinations conducted the meeting.

### Item 1: Revision of examination fees for all programmes

#### Resolution No 1:

It is unanimously resolved to accept and implement revised examination fees for Medical programmes (MBBS, MD/MS and DM/ MCh Programme)

The detail deliberation and discussions were done programme wise (MBBS, MD/MS and DM/MCh) on examination expenditure and following Fees mentioned in table are finalized.

This special meeting of Board of Examinations has been organized to Discuss & Implement Competency Based Medical Education Curriculum" (CBME) Regulations, 2023, published on 01.08.2023 and ammendments dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023, 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2023 and correspondence done by controller of Examinations MUHS

Item 1: Implementation of NO Grace marks system for MBBS batches for all phases (I, II, III-I & III-II MBBS)

#### Resolution 1:

The provision of 5 grace marks for any one subject available during MBBS examination is withdrawn with immediate effect.

Also, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor instructed Institute Heads to inform the change in GRACE MARK rule of MBBS for all batches students by issuing a circular and displaying the same on notice board of college as well as respective teaching department.

Item 2: Internal Assessment criteria for MBBS batches (2019-20,2020-21,2021-22,2022-23 & 2023-24) for all phases (I, II, III- I & III-II MBBS)

#### **Resolution 2:**

It is resolved that the passing criteria for Internal Assessment to be implemented is 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical/ clinical; not less than 40% marks in theory and practical separately) in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject.

Change in Internal Assessment formats will be implemented from 2023-24 admitted MBBS batch. The teaching department should inform the students about IA criteria for theory and practical's accordingly.

# Item 3: Supplementary Examinations for MBBS programme for all phases (I, II, III-I & III-II MBBS)

#### Resolution 3:

It is resolved that the Supplementary examinations will be conducted within 3-6 weeks from the date of declaration of the results of the main examination for every professional year, so that the candidates, who pass, can join the main batch for progression with immediate effect for all batches.

Institute head will inform this rule to MBBS students of all phases by issuing notice and displaying the same on notice board of college and respective teaching departments.

# Item 4: Passing Criteria for MBBS programme for all phases (I, II, III- I & III-II MBBS) Resolution 4:

It is unanimously resolved to accept and implement the change in Passing criteria for MBBS programme (I, II, III- I & III-II MBBS) as 50% marks in aggregate and 40% (minimum) in University conducted examination separately in Theory and in Practical (practical includes: practical/ clinical and viva voce) in order to be declared as passed in that subject with immediate effect for all batches.

Institute head will inform this rule to MBBS students of all phases by issuing notice and displaying the same on notice board of college and respective teaching departments.

Item 1: Implementation of Video Recording of the forthcoming annual UG Examinations for every phase of MBBS and submission of Form C to NMC after completion of the University examinations

#### Resolution 1:

- 1. The video recoding of all forthcoming MBBS University examinations practical examinations should be done with immediate effect.
- 2. The video recoding should be presently outsourced by the Dean of the respective Medical College and submit the bills to MGMIHS for reimbursement.
- 3. The Deans cum centre-In charge of MBBS University practical examination should arrange sufficient number of video recording systems with high resolution camera, Mike, storage backup etc.

- 4. The Convenor of practical examination by MGMIHS will be responsible for complete coverage and recording of University practical examinations.
- 5. The video should be in continuation starting from assignment /question of practical examination till the viva voce examination.
  - a. All the interactions in between examiner and examinee must be part of video recording. The viva-voce, case discussion and presentation Q & A between examiners and students should be recorded completely.
  - b. The convenors will be submitting the entire recording to the Dean cum Centre Incharge of the Medical College.
  - c. The duly filled 'Form C' to be uploaded and mailed to NMC after taking approval from Dean of the Medical College immediately after completion of University practical examination.
  - d. History taking part by the student alone need not be video recorded

e. The addition, deletion and editing of the Video is not permitted
