The MGMIHS Bioethics unit of Navi- Mumbai Campus celebrated the 'World Bioethics Day 2024' from 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> July 2024, as per guidelines given by chair. The theme for World Bioethics Day 2024 Competition was "Non-discrimination and non-stigmatization".

Under the guidance of **Dr. Shashank Dalvi**, Honorable Vice Chancellor, MGMIHS, Navi Mumbai and Head of MGMIHS Bioethics Unit, the 'World Bioethics Day 2024' was celebrated by **MGM's constituent colleges in Navi Mumbai and Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar campuses.**






Students participating in Rangoli competition on the eve of "World Bioethics Day 2024 celebrations"






