During the training for Degree / Diploma to be awarded in clinical disciplines, there shall be proper training in basic medical sciences related to the disciplines concerned; during the training for the degree to be awarded in basic medical sciences, there shall be training in applied aspects of the subject; as well as in allied subjects related to the disciplines concerned. In all Post Graduate training programmes, both clinical and basic medical sciences, emphasis is to be laid on preventive and social aspects, emergency care training in autopsies, biopsies, cytopsies, endoscopies and imaging which will be made available by concern department. e. 	(iii) The Oral examination shall be thorough and shall aim at assessing the candidate's knowledge and competence about the subject, investigative procedures, therapeutic techniques and other aspects of the speciality, which form a part of the examination.	
	A candidate shall secure not less than 50% marks in each head of passing which shall include (1) Theory, (2) Practical including clinical and viva voce examination. (Minimum 40 % in each paper)	
	b) Post Graduate Diploma examination in any subject shall consist of Theory, Clinical and Oral.
