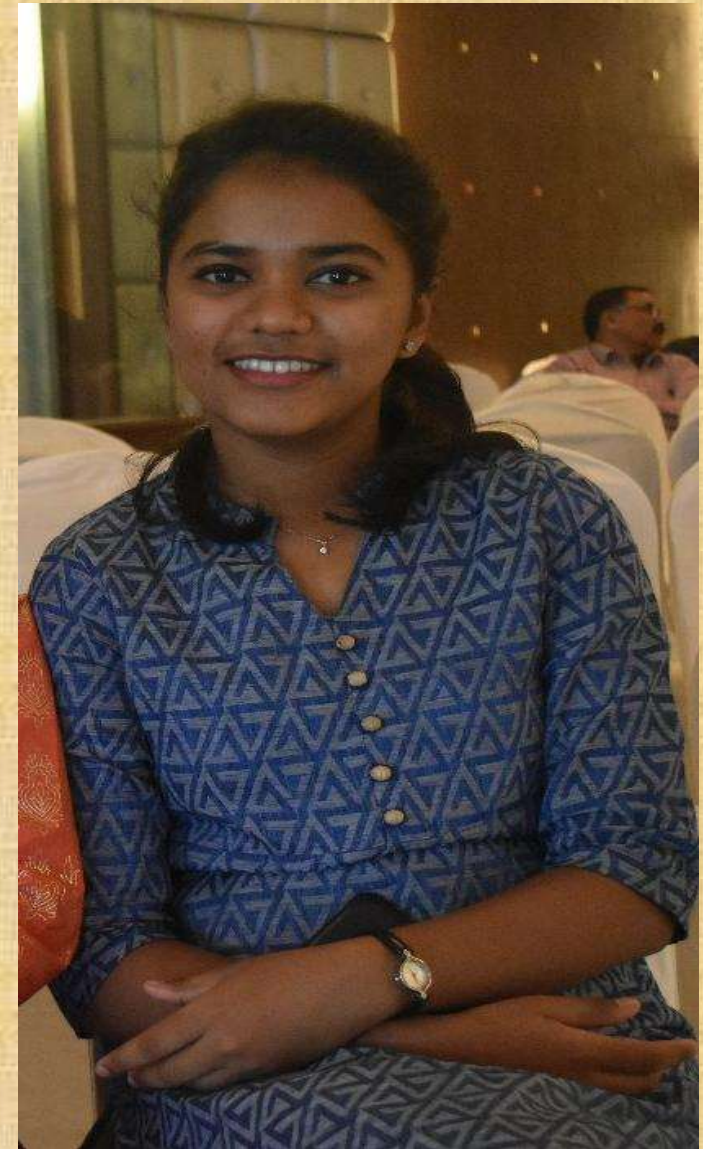


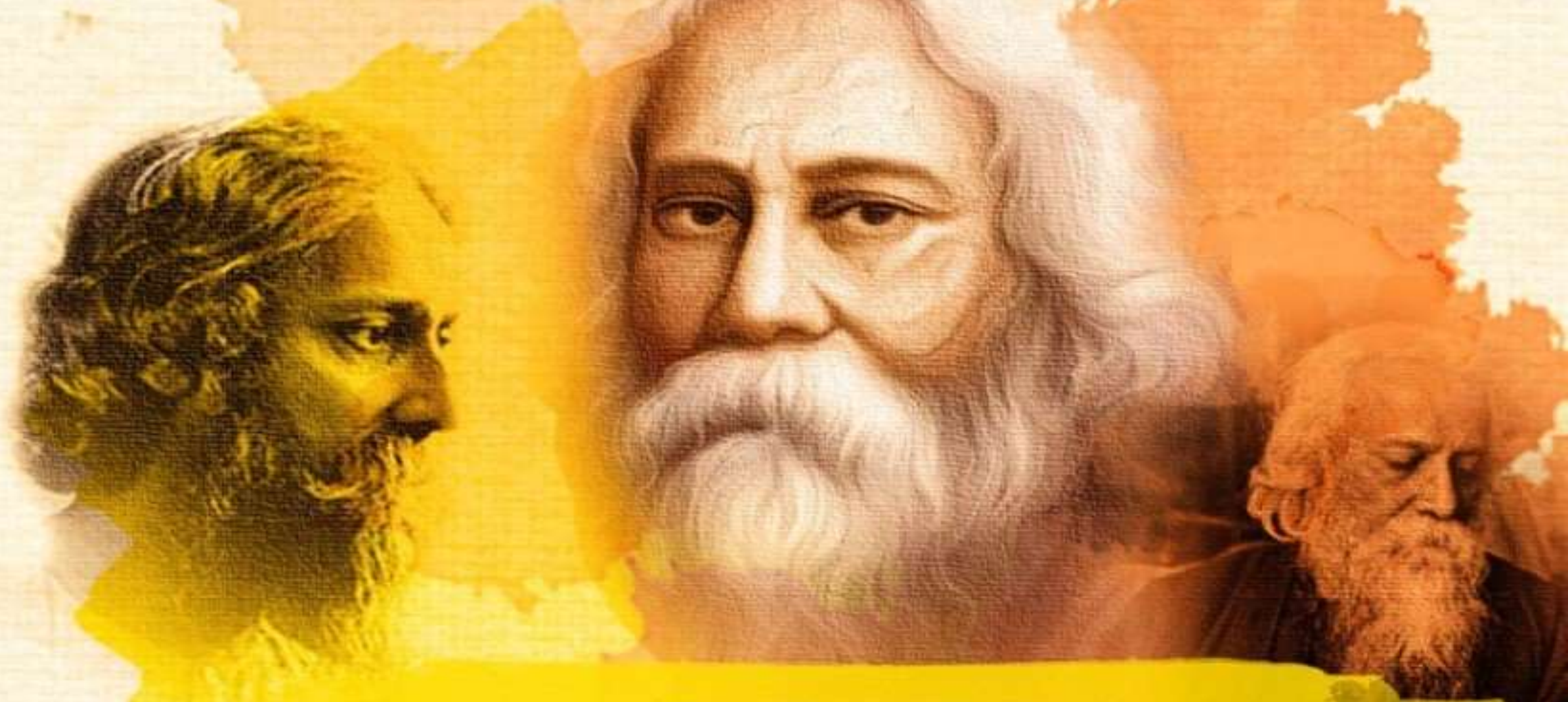

# Human values celebration 2020



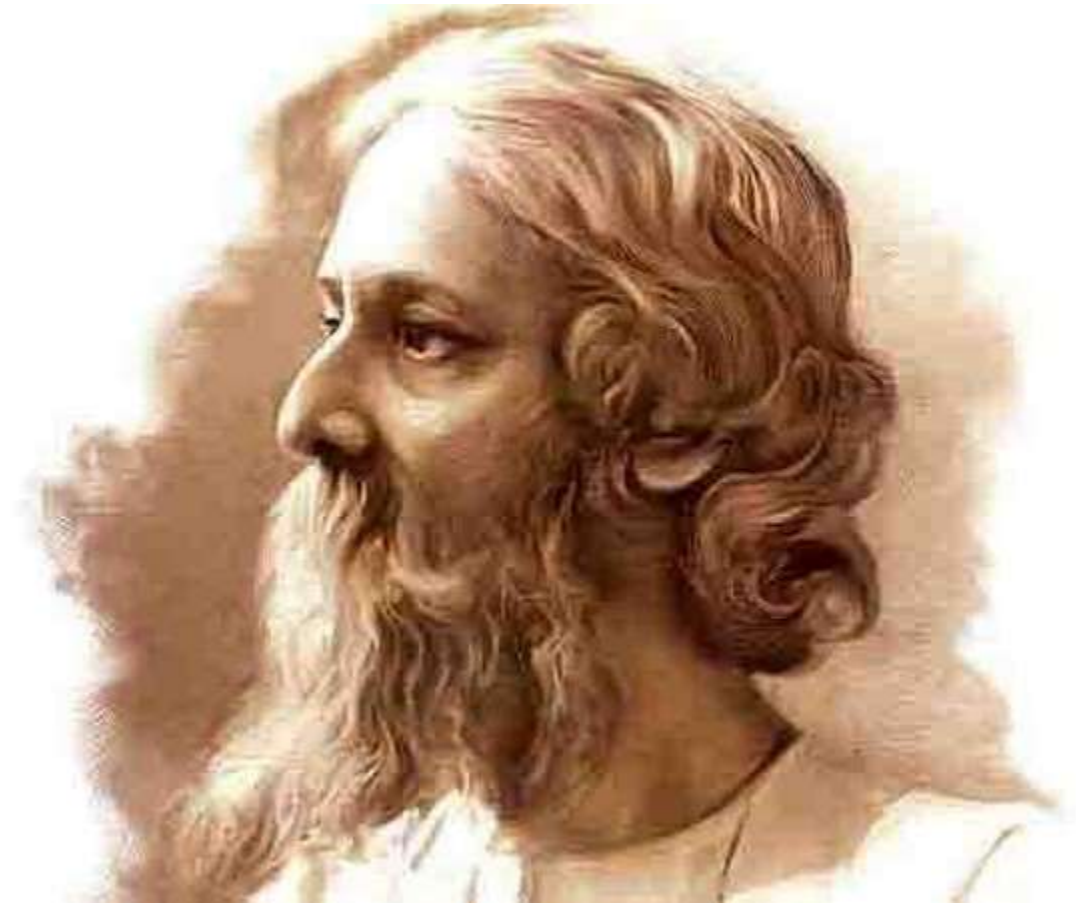

Rabindranath Tagore has given us many good works. And I was always inspired by his works.

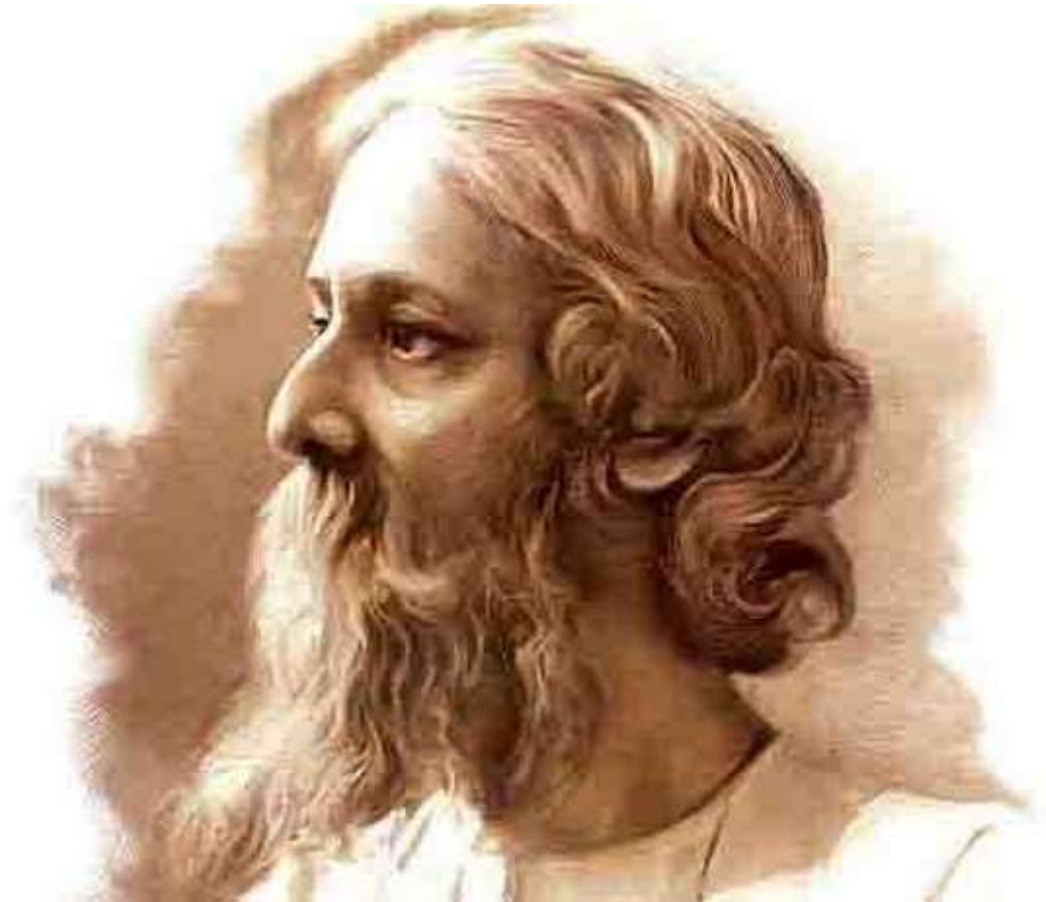

Aikla cholo re,”**

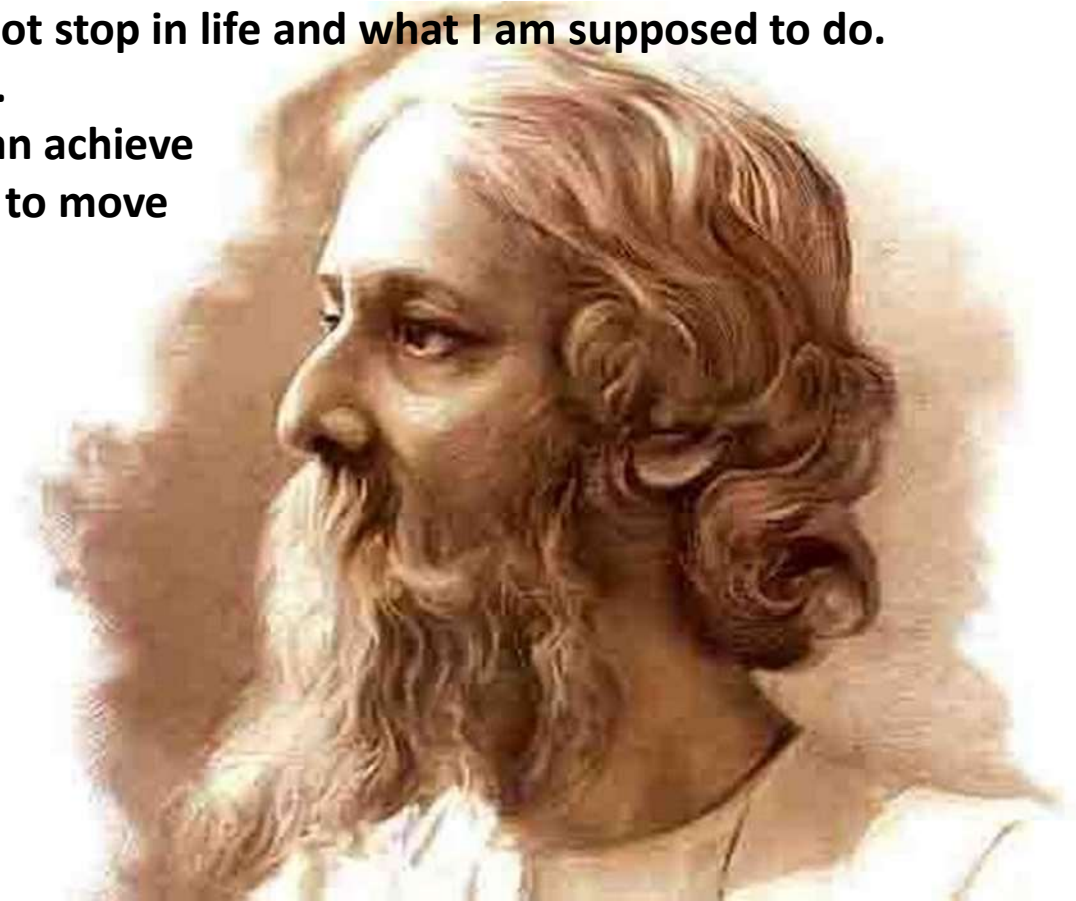
[If no one answers your call,
