The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 4th August, 2016, and is hereby published for general information:—

THE INDIAN MEDICAL COUNCIL (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2016 No. 39 OF 2016

[4th August, 2016.]

An Act further to amend the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- (1) This Act may be called the Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Act, 2016.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on 24th May, 2016.

Short title and commencement.

102 of 1956.

2. After section 10C of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), the following section shall be inserted, namely:—

Insertion of new section 10D.

“10D. There shall be conducted a uniform entrance examination to all medical educational institutions at the undergraduate level and post-graduate level through such designated authority in Hindi, English and such other languages and in such manner as may be prescribed and the designated authority shall ensure the conduct of uniform entrance examination in the aforesaid manner:

Uniform entrance examination for undergraduate and post-graduate level.

Provided that notwithstanding any judgment or order of any court, the provisions of this section shall not apply, in relation to the uniform entrance examination at the undergraduate level for the academic year 2016-17 conducted in accordance with any regulations made under this Act, in respect of the State Government seats (whether in Government Medical College or in a private Medical College) where such State has not opted for such examination.”

Amendment
of section 33.

3. In section 33 of the principal Act, after clause (*ma*), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(mb) the designated authority, other languages and the manner of conducting of uniform entrance examination to all medical educational institutions at the undergraduate level and post-graduate level;”.

Repeal and
savings.

4. (1) The Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2016 is hereby repealed.

Ord. 4 of

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 as amended by the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of the said Act, as amended by this Act.

सं. भा.आ.प.-18(1)/2016-मेडि./176290.—भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद् अधिनियम, 1956 (1956 का 102) की धारा 33 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का इस्तेमाल करते हुए भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान परिषद् "स्नातकोत्तर चिकित्सा शिक्षा विनियमावली, 2000" में पुनः संशोधन करने के लिए केंद्र सरकार की पूर्व स्वीकृति से निम्नलिखित विनियम बनाती है, नामतः :-

- (i) इन विनियमों को "स्नातकोत्तर चिकित्सा शिक्षा (संशोधन) विनियमावली, 2017" कहा जाएगा।
(ii) ये सरकारी राजपत्र में उनके प्रकाशन की तारीख से प्रवृत्त होंगे।
- "स्नातकोत्तर चिकित्सा शिक्षा विनियमावली, 2000" में विनियम 9 के पश्चात् निम्नलिखित अभिवर्धन किए जाएंगे:

9 क एकसमान परामर्श

- सभी स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रमों (डिप्लोमा/एमडी/एमएस/डीएम/एम.सीएच.) में प्रवेश हेतु सभी चिकित्सा संस्थानों में राष्ट्रीय पात्रता प्रवेश परीक्षा की मेरिट सूची के आधार पर एकसमान परामर्श किया जाएगा।
- सम्मिलित राज्यों की 50% अखिल भारतीय कोटा सीटों हेतु परामर्श के लिए नामित प्राधिकारी स्वास्थ्य महानिदेशालय होगा। ये परामर्श, वर्तमान योजना के अनुसार केवल डिप्लोमा और एमडी/एमएस पाठ्यक्रमों हेतु ही हैं।
- राज्य/संघ शासित राज्यों के सभी चिकित्सा शिक्षा संस्थानों एवं केन्द्र सरकार, राज्य सरकार, विश्वविद्यालय, मानित विश्वविद्यालय, ट्रस्ट, सोसाइटी या एक कम्पनी/अल्पसंख्यक संस्थानों/निगमों द्वारा संचालित चिकित्सा शिक्षा संस्थानों में स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम (डिप्लोमा/एमडी/एमएस/डीएम/एम.सीएच.) में सभी प्रवेश हेतु परामर्श राज्य सरकार द्वारा किया जाएगा। इन एकसमान परामर्शों का पूर्णतया पर्यवेक्षण, निर्देशन और नियंत्रण राज्य सरकार के अधीन होगा।

MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 10th March, 2017

No. MCI-18(1)/2016-Med./176290.—In exercise of powers conferred by Section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Medical Council of India with the previous sanction of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations to further amend the “Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000” namely:—

1. (i) These regulations may be called the “Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2017.”
- (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the “Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000”, the following additions shall be made after Regulation 9:—

9A. Common Counseling

- (1) There shall be a common counselling for admission to all Postgraduate Courses (Diploma/MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.) in all Medical Educational Institutions on the basis of merit list of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test.
- (2) The designated authority for counselling for the 50% All India Quota seats of the contributing States shall be conducted by the Directorate General of Health Services. Such counselling as per the existing scheme shall be only for Diploma and MD/MS courses.
- (3) The counselling for all Postgraduate Courses (Diploma/MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.) in all Medical Educational Institutions in a State/Union Territory, including Medical Educational Institutions established by the Central Government, State Government University, Deemed University, Trust, Society or a Company/Minority Institutions/Corporations shall be conducted by the State Government. Such common counselling shall be under the over-all superintendence, direction and control of the State Government.
