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8	Master of Public Health	<p>Both the Master in Public Health (MPH) and Master in Hospital Administration (MHA) programs are being conducted for more than 4 years</p> <p>a. There are similar courses in both the programs with some differences in syllabus in the Ist semester.</p> <p>b. Some of the portion is in too detail and not required for the requisite skills to be developed by the post graduate of that particular program.</p> <p>c. Some portion is required to develop the requisite skills by the post graduate but included only in one of the programs.</p> <p>d. There is combination of subtopics in the subjects is in such a fashion that though the teaching is being conducted commonly, the examination cannot be common and increases unnecessary burden on the exam administration.</p> <p>e.
