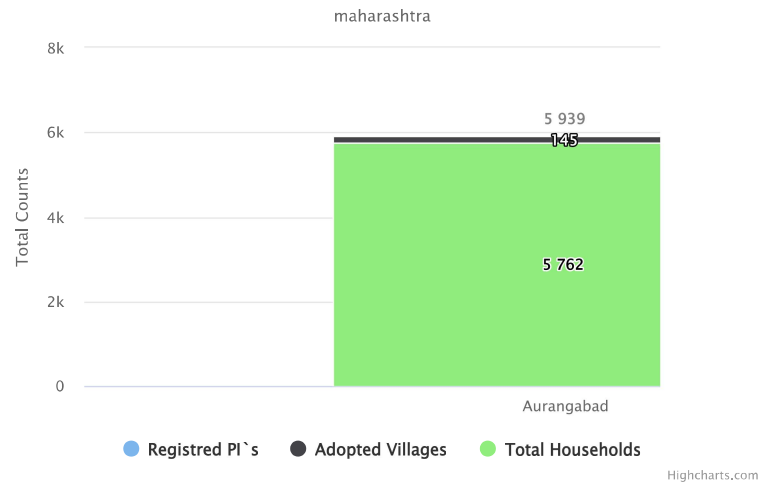

ANGANWADI VISIT

Anganwadi Services also known as Umbrella Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented by States and Union Territories.

Objectives

- To improve the nutritional and health status of children in the age group of 0-6 years.
- To lay foundation for the proper psychological, physical and social development of the child.
- To reduce the incidence of mortality, morbidity, malnutrition and school dropouts.
- To achieve effective co-ordination of policy and implementation amongst the various departments to promote child development.
- To enhance the capability of the mother to look after the normal health and nutritional needs of the child through proper nutrition and health education.

Services provided are :-

- Supplementary nutrition.
- Pre-school non-formal education.

RS

- Nutrition and health education.
- Immunization.
- Health Check-up.
- Referral services such as children in age group of 0-6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers.

In Sindon village, Aurangabad, we find two Anganwadi's which was situated there.

We went to visit it to talk and see the anganwadi's functioning but the anganwadi's were closed.

By asking local's, we came to know that the Anganwadi is opened on three times a day, i.e. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

As our visit was planned on Saturday, we were unable to visit it, as it was closed.

From the ~~same~~ information given by local's, the immunisation of the children is hold only once a month i.e. every first Wednesday of the month. National Immunisation Schedule is followed by them.

Covid Vaccine was also given by them in pandemic.

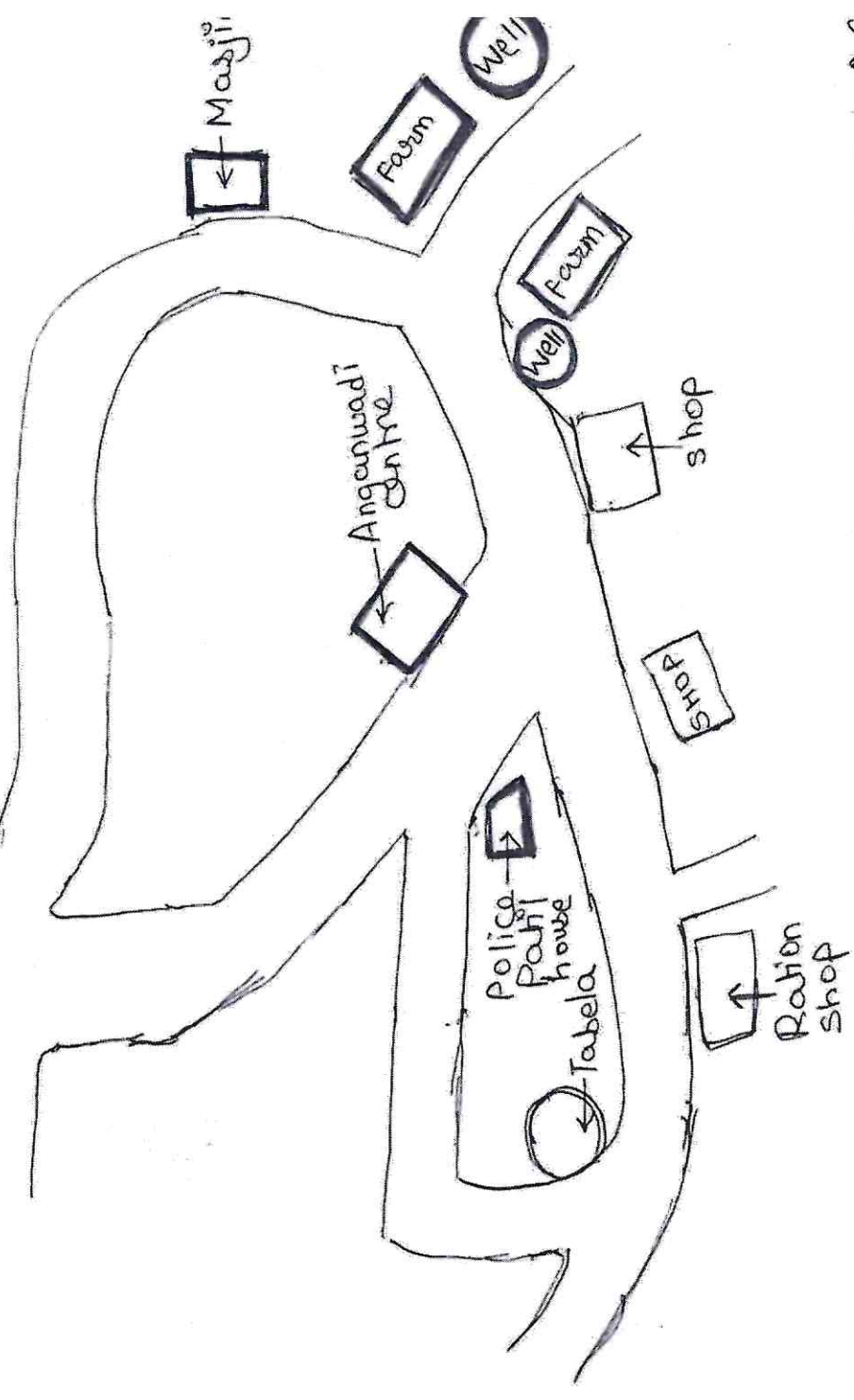
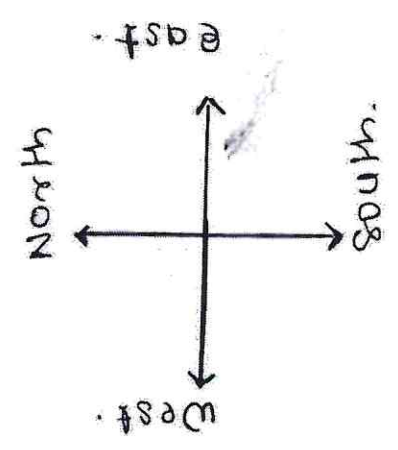
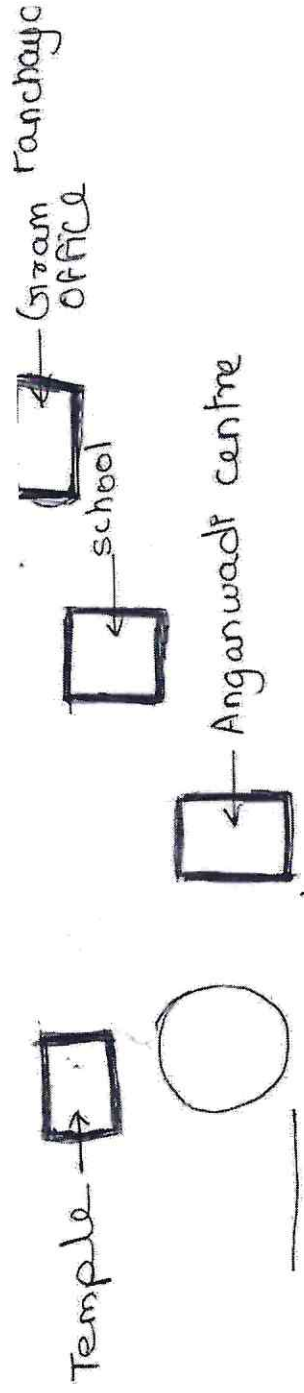

Visit to Sindhon village : Communication with villagers

On Saturday, Sept 10 2022 we visited the Sindon village and had communication with the local villagers under guidance of Dr. Surve Sir.

We asked the villagers about their day to day life in the village. The information provided by the villagers helped us to recognize the problems they are facing while leading their daily life.

Water Supply: The water is supplied to the village through tap water on every third day. As a source, there are three wells in the village out of which ~~2~~ 2 have dried up and only one is available.

The villagers stores the water mostly in large earthen pots for drinking purpose. The villagers often drink the boiled water. For daily usage, the water is stored in plastic tanks in most of the houses.

Waste disposal system: There is no proper waste disposal system in the village. The collection, segregation & proper disposal is not there. Most of the houses has only one dustbin. The villagers don't know the importance of organic &

Immunisation : The immunisation is provided to the pregnant women and children in the Aanganwadi on every first wednesday of month.

Control of vectors : There is no facility of any control measures for the spread of vector borne diseases. Due to dumping of garbage on open fields there is increased number of flies, mosquitoes & all sorts of insects. Some of the villagers use mosquito nets and most of the villagers use chemicals like 'Good night' for protecting themselves from vector borne diseases like malaria, dengue, etc.

Housing pattern : Most of the houses in the village are pakka house. There is overcrowding in some of the house. Very few houses had their separate washrooms, most of the villagers defecate in open field. The houses are ~~are~~ not well ventilated.

Grain Dukan : We came across the Swasta Dhanya Dukan where food grains are provided at low cost to the village under various government programmes. The various yojanas are 'Antayoday Aana Yojana', 'Pradhanya kartumb Labharti Yojana' and 'APL farmer yojana'.

Local Shop : There was only one shop which was open on the day of our visit. The shop had all the basic day to day materials for sale. It also had availability of some medicinal drugs such as Pan D, Omeprazole, Paracetamol, etc. The shop also had facility of online payment method.

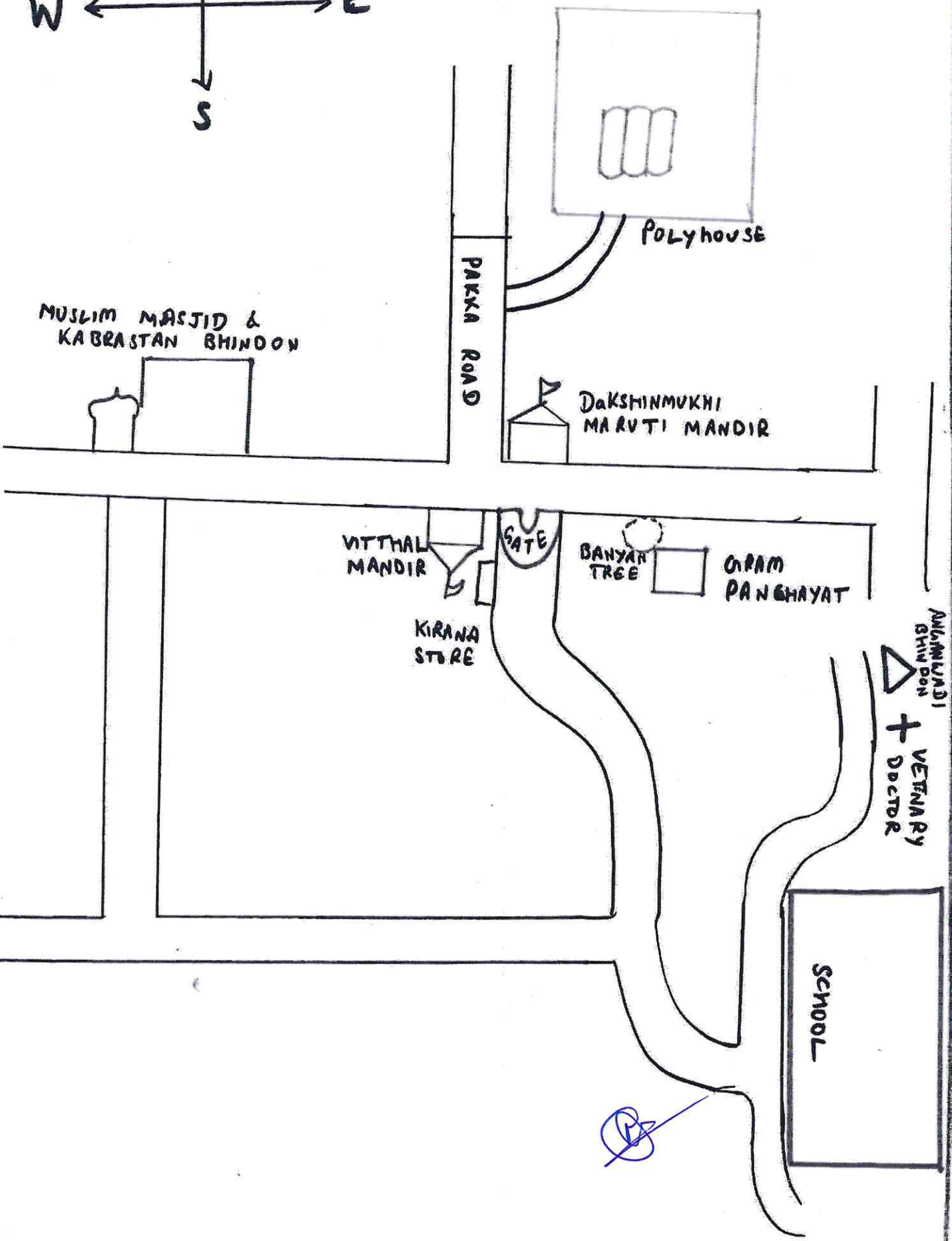
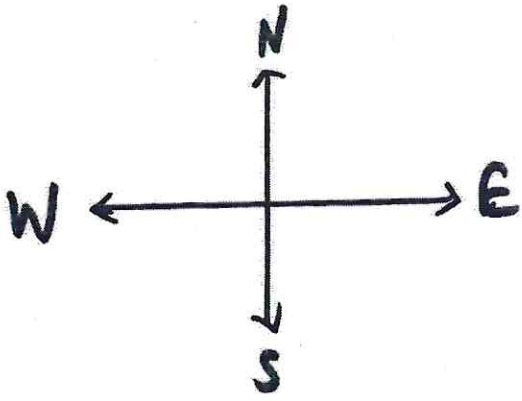

GRAM SABHA

Name of the Sarpanch : Smt. Pratiksha Kshirsagar

We visited the Gram Sabha and found it that it operates three days a week — Monday, Tuesday and Thursday.

→ The people seemed unsatisfied with the working of the panchayat and the panchayat lacked its core members too.

→ For the panchayat to work effectively, there should be a minimum of seven members — One Sarpanch and the rest Samiti is formed by the electoral members.

→ People stated that they were not happy with the working of the Panchayat and they refused to listen to the problems of the people and even if they did, they refused to acknowledge the problems.

→ CHANGES WHICH CAN BE DONE

- 1) The panchayat Samiti should be consistent and should elect more members.
- 2) They should hold regular meetings with the villagers and listen to their problems.
- 3) The people of Bhindon if unsatisfied with the work should elect a new Samiti.

RELIGIOUS INSTITUTES

TEMPLES :

Dakshinmukhi Maruti Mandir -

- It is a south facing temple, located at the major crossroad of Bhindon, making it one of the main landmarks of the area.
- It is a very old institute made up of stones.

Working :

- There is no appointed authority to run the temple.
- The devotees run & take care of the temple as and when they visit.

Viththal Mandir -

- It is also one of the main institutes of the area, located next to the Dakshinmukhi Maruti Mandir.

Functioning -

- Both the temples are taken care of by the devotees whenever they visit.
- There is no mass gathering that takes place, in order to celebrate any festival

MOSQUE -

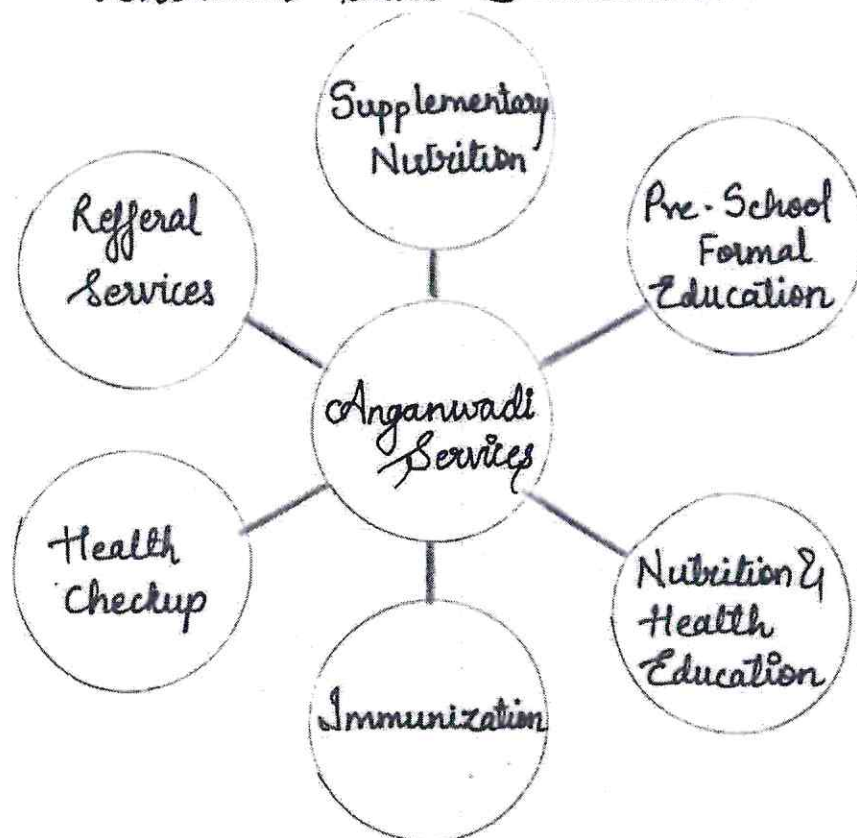
Muslim Masjid and Kabristaan Bhindon.

ANGANWADI

Anganwadi was started by Indian Government in 1975 as part of the Integrated Child Development Services program [ICDS]

PURPOSE: Combat hunger and Malnutrition in children and Adolescents.



There is one Anganwadi Worker [AWW] at Bhindon. She is paid an honorarium of ₹ 5,000/- per month by the government.

Name of the [AWW]: Mrs. Anuradha Chagan Rathod.

At present there are '30' under 5 year of age kids registered in the Anganwadi.

In the 1st week of September, National Nutrition Month was celebrated aka पोषण अभियान as प्यरा प्यरात पोषण उत्सव

Working of the Anganwadi :-

The [AWW] looks after the daily activities of the Anganwadi.

The kids under 5-year of age are taught about english and hindi letters. They are also taught numbers and names of fruits and vegetables. Monthly height and weight examination of the children is done. The kids are immunized as per National Immunization Schedule.

The ASHA co-ordinates with AWW in Antenatal Care of all pregnant females.

All the eligible residents avail the facilities at the Anganwadi and follow their advice/instructions religiously.
